God's Greatest Mission --- Motherhood

Deuteronomy 6: 1-13; Psalms 127

Remember the 3 generation collapse!

I. The Importance of Womanhood — 7 most influential mothers

- **Eve** — Cursed all Humans with bad decisions, **DISOBEDIENCE to God's Word**
- **Noah's wife** --- saved all mankind with her **OBEDIENCE to God's Word**
- **Moses' Mother** — Jochebed --- brought deliverance by her Godliness and **OBEDIENCE, FAITH.**
- **Naomi and Ruth** — were used to create God's Blessings by their obedience and hunger for God, blessing the world with a man named DAVID and JESUS.
- **Rahab** — saved her people because of her hunger for God.
- **Hannah** --- Blessed us all because of Her Hunger for God.
- **Mary** --- the mother of Jesus blessed all by **obedience to God's calling.**

II. The Call of Womanhood — Missions

The Man and the Women were the very first called and commissioned Missionaries!

When God calls us to mission, He called us to:

- Be Empowered — “all power is given to me ... **BY HIM!**
- Employed --- God ye therefore ... **BY HIM!**
- Implement truth --- Preach/Teach ... **HIS TRUTH!**
- Separate — Baptize --- **UNTO HIM!**
- Deal with all kinds — Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, Uttermost --- **FOR HIM!**

This is what missionaries do, and this is what the mothers are called to do: Empower, Employ, Implant, Separate, deal with all kinds ... **FOR HIM!**

III. The Practical Practice of successful Womanhood – How to according to God Himself

Deuteronomy 6: 1-13 What does God say needs to be a part of the next generation in order for them to be a blessing and to be blessed?

- Aim your life at possessing God's Favored Spot on the Planet! It is wonderful to be assigned such a job as this, "Raising God's Children". Psalms 127: 3 *"...children are a heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward."*
- Help your children aim at becoming God's Favored...Vs. 2

Seven qualities to instill into them given by God:

- **Personally Possess** — received personally vs1
- **Fear the LORD thy God** vs. 2
- **Hear the LORD THY God** vs. 3,4
- **Love the LORD thy God** vs. 5 — Head on breast of God
- **Embrace the word of God** --- vs. 6
- **Teach the word of God** (diligently) — 8150 — to pierce, as with grief as with a sword or sharp arrow! vs. 6
- **Modeling the word of God** — shalt talk, sittest, walkest, liest down, risest up...

HOW? vs 8-9

- Sign upon hands --- 226 --- signs --- pointing to God's work... doing God's work with your hands... acting out god's work.
- frontlet of your eyes
- posts of thy house
- gates of thy house

First calling is to possess the relationship offered by the creator! **It is important to note that we as parents and in particular the mother is to (vs 18) do what is right in the sight of the LORD and let them watch you!**

Vs. 10 "And it shall be, when...

Vs. 13 “Thou shalt fear, serve, and swear by His name... This is actually a statement that calls us to consciously make a decision to do these things.

Swear — 7650 — confirm with an oath, pledge allegiance to god through an oath!

Swear —7650 — Shava — 7651 — Shivah ---# 7—it is clear that this word is used to call for an oath, Oaths were sealed by 7s.

Genesis 21: 22-30 Abraham and Abimelech, used 7 lambs to seal a commitment; also 1st Samuel: Sampson’s 7 ropes and 7 locks of hair...

Let’s stand before God in a commitment of 7 today:

I _____commit to You my God, to make You my Supreme focus, I will make it my greatest aim to minister to Your children, I will model my relationship, I will fear the loss of Your favor, I will hear and observe all Your words, I will love You with all my heart, I will embrace Your word as my greatest possession, I will teach my children diligently in every area of my conduct, I will accept my motherhood as the most important mission of my life. This I commit to God the Father (my Creator), to Jesus His son (my Savior) and the Holy Spirit (my Helper). To this I make my pledge, with deep gratitude for the opportunity to be the ministering agent to the next generation of God’s creation (His Heritage).

Psalms 127: 3 “...children are a heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward.”
