Child Abuse Awareness Training

On Tuesday, July 18, 2017, beginning at 5:30 p.m., a Child Abuse Awareness Training DVD seminar will be held in the Youth Center's Junior Church Area. <u>This seminar is mandatory for all</u> <u>Preschool and Church employees, and ANYONE</u> <u>who works with children in any capacity -- Sunday School teachers/helpers, Wednesday night</u> <u>teachers/helpers, nursery workers, Junior</u> <u>Church helpers, VBS workers, Camp counselors,</u> <u>Youth workers, etc.</u> (A child is defined as anyone from birth to 18 years old, unless in the military or married).

We will provide dinner for all who attend the training. Dinner will be served at 5:30 p.m., and the training seminar will begin at 6:00 p.m. The DVD seminar will last approximately one hour, with a 25-question test to follow. All who pass the test will receive a certificate of completion. Child care will be provided for all who attend **and register their children for care when RSVPing.**
