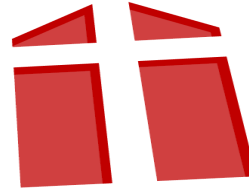

MILITARY BIBLE STICK CAMPAIGN

Today is the last Sunday to contribute to our BibleStick campaign. Our goal is \$5,000, which would provide them for two full battalions! **So far, we have collected \$2,700.**

A Military Bible Stick is an audio drama presentation of the New Testament that is simple and easy to use. Each month, U.S. Military chaplains receive 27,500 requests for BibleSticks. As of May 1, of this year, 802,014 BibleSticks have been placed in the hands of our military who have requested them.

Child Abuse Awareness Training

On Tuesday, July 18, 2017, beginning at 5:30 p.m., a Child Abuse Awareness Training DVD seminar will be held in the Youth Center's Junior Church Area. **This seminar is mandatory for all Preschool and Church employees, and ANYONE who works with children in any capacity -- Sunday School teachers/helpers, Wednesday night teachers/helpers, nursery workers, Junior Church helpers, VBS workers, Camp counselors, Youth workers, etc.** (A child is defined as anyone from birth to 18 years old, unless in the military or married).

Dinner will be served at 5:30 p.m., and the training seminar will begin at 6:00 p.m. The DVD seminar will last approximately one hour, with a 25-question test to follow.
