His Kingdom.

Euphrates River on the north

Egyptian border on the south

Arabian Desert on the east

Mediterranean Coast on the west

1 Kings 4:1-21 Solomon's Servants

1. Azariah and Abiathar – the priests
2. Elihoreph and Ahiah – scribes
3. Jehosephat – his personal historian
4. Azariah and Zabad – Principal officers (Nathan's Sons)
5. Ahishar – manager of the Kingdom estate
6. Adoniram – financial chief
7. Benaiah – Captain of the Army and Special Forces
8. 20,000 Servants Total / 14,000 were courtiers

1 Kings 4:22-28 Solomon's Food

1. 150 bushels (2,580 gallons) of flour
2. 300 bushels (5,160 gallons) of meal
3. 20 Oxen / 100 Sheep / roebucks and fallow deer / fatted fowl
4. In one day
5. In Ecclesiastes, Solomon says he has eaten anything he wanted.

1 Kings 9-10 Solomon's Army

1. Navy = hundreds of ships that traveled all over the known world.
2. Army = 12,000 horsemen
3. 2,000 chariots made of silver / 600 shekels of silver per chariot (1 Kings 10:29)
4. Sidonian and Hittite mercenaries
5. Shields of gold

1 Kings 7 Solomon's House

1. Took 13 years to build it
2. 200 Kilos of Gold for the walls
3. Massive porches and columned porticoes made of Cedar trees
4. Lattice windows
5. Hand-carved walls sculpted like palm granites and flowers
6. All was beautiful and custom made
7. He had a wing for his 700 wives and 300 hundred concubines (1 Kings 11:3)
8. He had a wing for the Pharaoh of Egypt
9. His throne made of pure Ivory and plated in pure gold
10. Walking up to his throne there were 6 steps each guarded by two sculpted lions made of pure gold
11. In his throne room there was a molten sea 5 cubits deep and 30 cubits in circumference.
12. A swimming pool of clear water before you went to the throne.

1 Kings 10:14-29 Solomon's Wealth

1. Solomon averaged 636 Talents of pure gold annually (1 Kings 10:14)
2. In one year, his navy delivered 420 Talents of gold in one trip from India
3. \$2,000 per ounce
4. 25 tons per year for forty years = \$64,300,800,000 in pure gold
5. He had spices, silver, gems and metals mined and imported from all over the world
6. Linens and clothes from all over the world
7. Solomon ate completely with gold utensils (1 Kings 7:50)
8. 40,000 stalls for all his horses. Imported horses from Egypt and Arabia.

9. Exotic animals (Apes and Peacocks) (1 Kings 10:22)
10. To give you an Idea of Solomon's wealth
11. Donald Trump \$3.5 Billion / Mark Zuckerberg \$70.9B / Warren Buffet \$75B / Bill Gates \$85.6B / Jeff Bezos \$81.5B / John Rockefeller \$663B / Andrew Carnegie \$310B / Tsar Nicholas II \$300B / Henry Ford \$199 / Cornelius Vanderbilt \$185B
12. Solomon \$2.1 Trillion in total wealth
13. Solomon had all the world has to offer
