- My father's yoke was heavier my yoke will be heavier.
- My father chastised you with whips I will chastise you with scorpions.

# Jeroboam of Ephraim

Labor force leader

- 1. Ahijah the prophet prophesied
- 2. Solomon threatened him
- 3. He fled to Egypt
- 4. Shishak the Pharaoh
- 5. Solomon died and Jeroboam returned to Israel
- 6. 10 tribes rebelled against Rehoboam

## **Chapter 12:25-33**

#### Verses 25-27 He did not believe God's Word

- 1. Jeroboam was told through the prophet Ahijah of his throne being secure (11:28-40).
- 2. God promised him success.
- 3. God predicted it through the prophet.
- 4. He tried to keep people from going to Jerusalem.
- 5. He did not believe.
- 6. Many times we lose sight of God's promises.
- 7. Many times, we take matters into our own hands.

# Verses 28-29 He did not obey God's Word

- 3. One in Bethel (Genesis 28:10-19 Jacob's Ladder).

- 5. This is the greatest insult to all God had done.
- 6. God did not like golden calves.

- 1. New priest of the lowest of people.
- 2. Low people in high places.
- 3. New feasts.
- 4. New Holidays.
- 5. Total rejection.
