- 4. Shalmaneser, Syrian King.
- 5. He then besieged the city for 3 years.
- 6. Took prisoners into exile.
- 7. This happened because they walked in the statutes of the heathen.
- 8. Verse 9 They did secretly those things that were not right.
- 9. Verses 13 The preaching of the prophets was not enough.
- 10. Warnings were not effective.
- 11. Verse 18 God removed them from out of His sight.
- 12. Verse 23 As He had said.

## Verses 24-41 The Curse of Religion took Over

- 1. The Babylonians, Cuthites, Avites, Hamathites, Sapharvaimites moved in.
- 2. God sent lions into the land to kill them.
- 3. Egypt plagues; Philistines (1 Samuel); Hemorrhoids.
- 4. The King of Assyria sent a Priest from Israel to teach Jehovah worship.
- 5. He brought rituals and elements of Judaism.

- 6. They mingled Judaism and Idol worship into one religion.
- 7. Verse 33 They feared the Lord but served their own gods.
- 8. They did not really fear the Lord.
- 9. Verses 40-41 They did not hearken.
- 10. So they feared the Lord and served graven images.
- 11. Both their children and their children's children.
- 12. They do it until this day.
- 13. They do it to this day also.
- 14. 313 AD The Edict of Milan Constantine.
- 15. Revelation 2:18-27 Thyatira They were a church in the practice of idolatry.
