## National Day of Prayer Theme for 2018

The National Day of Prayer was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, the law was unanimously amended by both the House and the Senate and signed into law by President Ronald Reagan on Thursday, May 5, 1988, designating the first Thursday of May as a day of national prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation.

Prayer brings people together. Prayer reminds us that we are created in God's image and He desires for us to represent Him everywhere we go. Prayer brings UNITY. In 2018, our theme will be **Pray for America - UNITY**, based upon Ephesians 4:3 - *Making every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.*"

You are eligible to donate blood if:

- You are at least 17 years old, (age 16 with written parental consent in Maryland, Pennsylvania and Virginia). There is no upper age limit.
- You weigh at least 110 pounds.
- You are in good health. (Don't worry, many prescription drugs taken on a regular basis are acceptable.)
- We will be collecting whole blood units. FYI......If anyone has **RARE BLOOD TYPES......o+, o-, a- or b- blood types**, there is also the option for donating double red blood cells only. With this type of donation, the person receives back their white blood cells and platelets/ plasma, along with saline solution. It takes about 20 minutes longer than a whole blood donation. You may still choose to donate only whole blood and not double red blood cells.

Time slots are in 15 min. increments, and 4 to 6 people can register for a specific time slot. You may also visit <u>redcrossblood.org</u> or sign up at church services (coming soon)!
