God tells us not to forget:

Deuteronomy 4: 9 “Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life; but teach them thy sons and thy son’s sons.”

Deuteronomy 4: 23 “Take heed unto yourselves, lest ye forget the covenant of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of anything, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.”

Deuteronomy 6: 1-12 Then beware lest thou forget the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.”

Judges 3: 7-8a “And the Children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and forgot the LORD their God, and served Baalim and the groves. Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel...”

Psalms 9: 17 “The wicked shall be turned into hell and all the nations that forget God.”

Psalms 50: 22 “Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver.”

Psalms 88: 12 “Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? And thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?”

Psalms 106: 13 “They soon forgot his works; they waited not for his counsel.”

Jeremiah 2: 32 “Can a maid forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? yet my people have forgotten me days without number.”

Jeremiah 18: 15 “Because my people have forgotten me, they have burned incense to vanity, and they have caused them to stumble in their ways from the ancient paths, to walk in paths, in a way not cast up;”

Jeremiah 50: 6 “My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from the mountains; they have gone mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.”

2nd Peter 1: 3-9, 15 “Moreover I will endeavor that ye may be able after my decrease to have these things always in remembrance.”

James 1: 22-24 “But be ye doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving you own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass. For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.”
