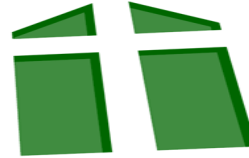

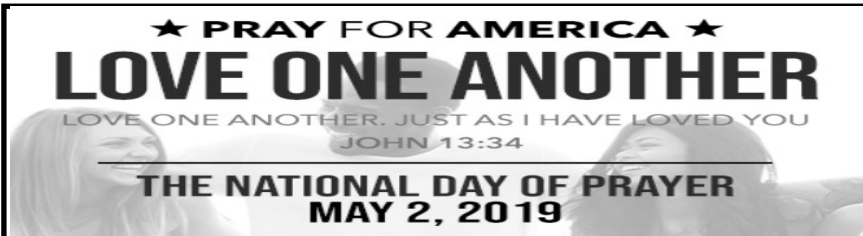
This year's BACK YARD BIBLE CAMP will be Monday, July 29 - Friday, August 2 at the Falko residence.
