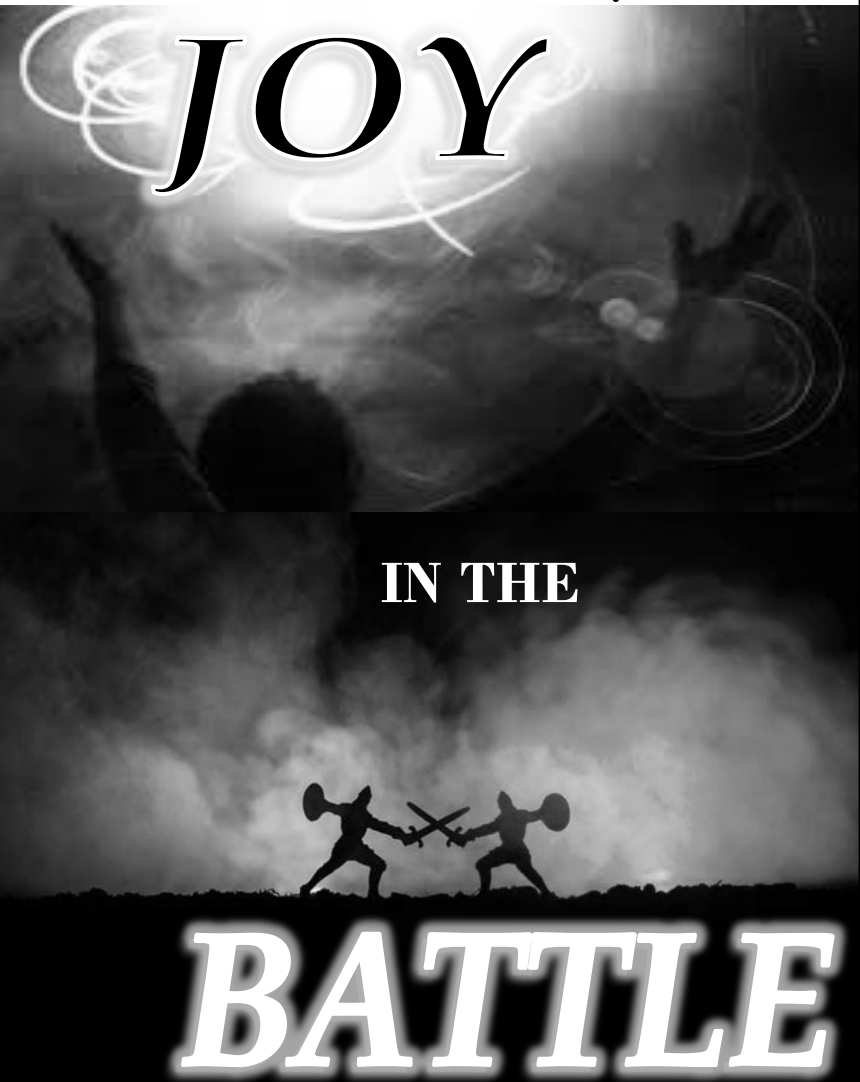
KENYA MISSION TRIP
