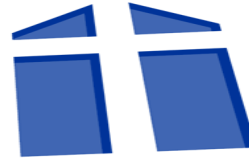

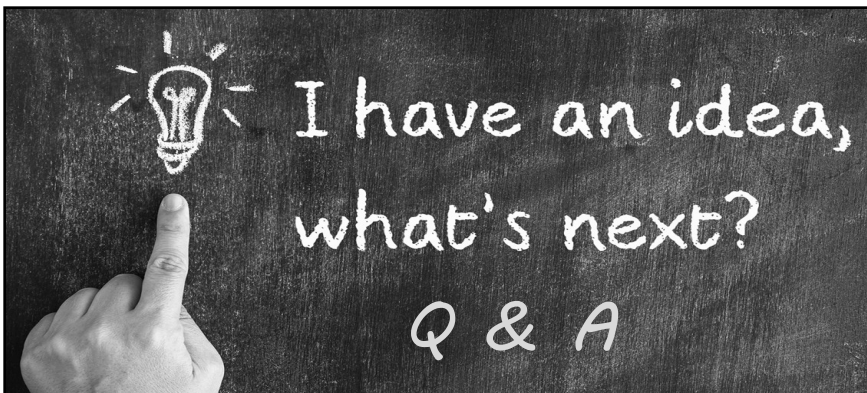

Q - I have a new idea for Pleasant View! How do I present it?

A - First, determine if it is a *new ministry* or a *new event* that would be a *part of an existing ministry*. See definitions below:

New Ministry: Any item totally separate from an existing program or ministry at PVBC.

New Program/Event for an Existing Ministry: An idea, program or event that would be part of a ministry already in progress at PVBC.

For New Ministries, complete a **NEW MINISTRY REQUEST FORM**, available in the information rack outside the office doors.

For New Program/Event for an Existing Ministry, submit a request in the form of a letter or memo to the Chairman of the existing ministry for their review. If accepted, they will submit the request to the Church Administrator for Admin. Committee review. The request **MUST** contain the following info:

- Complete description of program/idea.
- Timeframe (weekly, monthly, annually, one-time only).
- Purpose of program/idea.
- How does this idea relate to the ministry and church?
- What will be the needs (financing, space, equipment, etc.)
- Name and phone # of individual submitting the request.

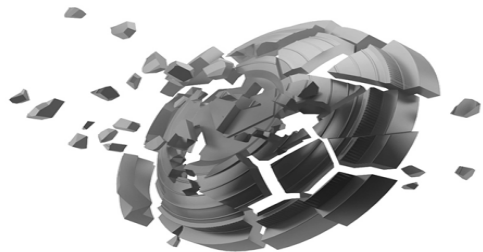
