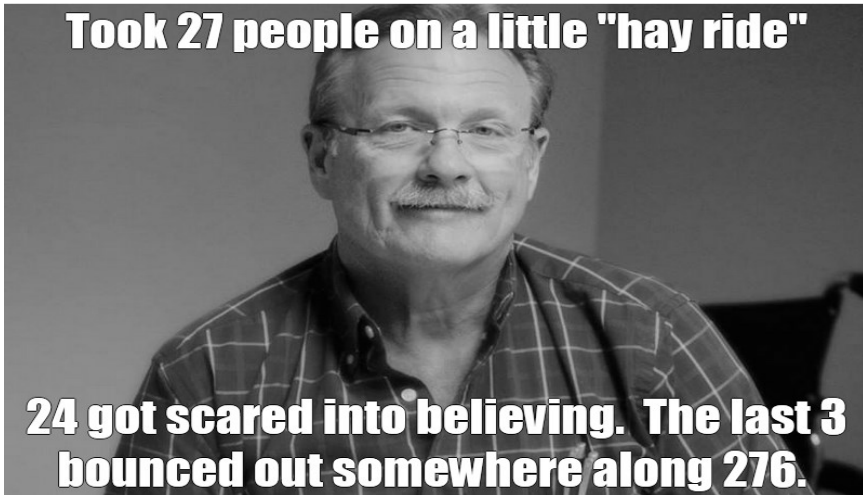

Please let them know how much they are valued!



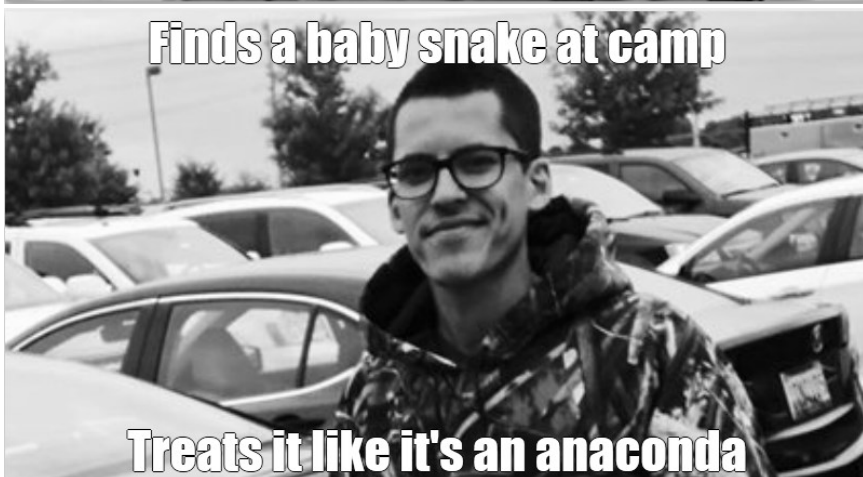

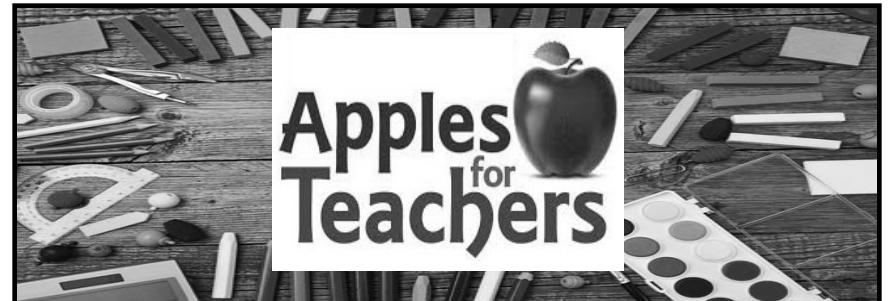
