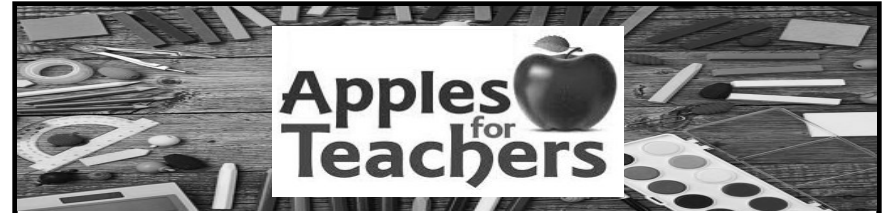

MOMS OF PRODIGALS SUPPORT GROUP


